

Level 1

- Developing their gross motor skills by working with Knob cylinder, Knobless cylinder and Pink tower.
- Introduction to numbers 1-5 with their quantities
- Introduction to basic concepts like big- small, tall-short, long –short etc....
- Introduction of capital letters S, A, T, P, I, N through Jolly phonetics.
- Introduction to primary colours
- Tracing curves and circles.

Level 2

- Introduction and writing of capital letters C, K, E, M, R, H & D through Jolly phonetics.
- Association of numbers 1-20 with their quantities and writing numbers 1-10.
- Working with Red rods, Number rods and Tracing numbers and letters.

Level 3


- Introduction to the three letter words of “a”, their rhyming words, singular & plural
- Introduction to the 1st set of sight words I, a, an in, it, on, the, and, her, his.
- Introduction and writing of numbers 51-100.
- Introduction to shapes Cone, Cube and Cylinder through different activities: Cone- Cone ice-cream; Cube- Dice; Cylinder- Sound cylinder box.

Theme for this month

Plants: We spoke about the different parts of the plant. In the first week children sowed black gram in a cup as an individual project and sowed moong in a transparent tray as a group project and saw different stages of plant growth. In the second week, the children brought fruits to eat every day and at the end of the week they made fruit salad and fruit mask. In the third week, we made vegetable book marks, made vegetable prints and at the end of the week, we had sprouting delight. In the fourth week we spoke about junk food and healthy food, made a cut out of a tooth and pasted a picture of healthy food on the white part and junk food on the yellow part of the tooth. We also had a puppet show with the story line of fruits and vegetables.
