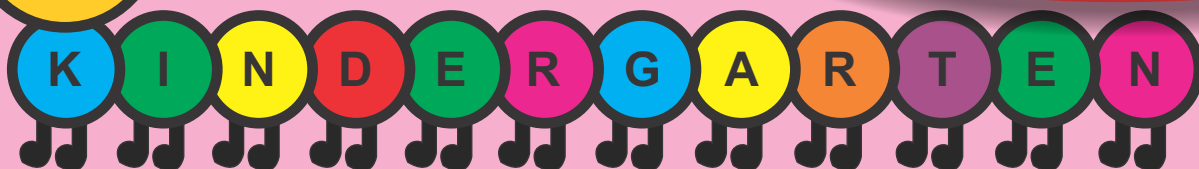


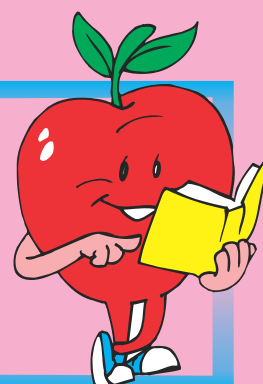
# NEWS LETTER

### Level 2

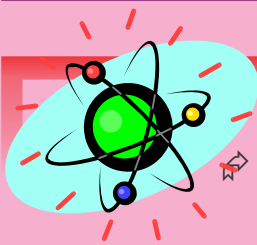
- Introduction to Capital letters C, K, E, H, M, R, D.

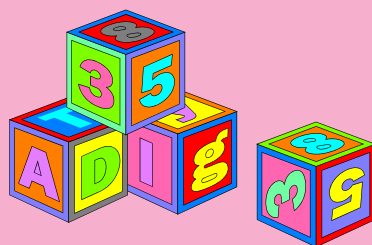
