The teacher revised concepts of fruits and vegetables, animal world, sense organs through stories and showing them flash cards. The teacher also conducted a quiz for children to recall the facts which they had learned throughout the year.

Literacy: The teacher revised alphabets from Aa to Zz with phonetic songs, children were given worksheets to write alphabets and associate sounds with respective pictures.

Revised of family words: 'ug' words, 'un' words, 'ot' words, 'ub' words, 'ut' words, 'it' words, 'in' words by showing flashcards and children enjoyed reading storybooks.


Numeracy: The teacher revised the concept of numbers from 1 to 50 by counting fingers and different kinds of objects. Children were given worksheets to associate numbers with respective objects. The concepts of before and after numbers were revised through games. Children enjoyed making patterns with different shapes and colours.

Theme for the Month

The teacher revised the concept of fruits and vegetables by showing children flashcards. They traced vegetables and fruits with stencils and coloured them. Children also enjoyed making Fruit Salad in class.

The teacher also revised concepts of personal hygiene by showing flashcards. She discussed about things which we use to clean the environment and ourselves; she emphasised on the importance of cutting nails, brushing teeth, and washing hands before and after eating.

Language

- Story reader: Min makes a New Friend
- Revision of family words: 'ing' words, 'qu' words, 'th' words
- **Revision:** opposites, prepositions, colours, singular and plural forms through games and activities. The teacher reinforced the same concepts through worksheets.
- Introduction to comprehension passages
- Writing one word or simple one line answers

Arithmetic

- Introduction to single digit Addition and Subtraction with different kinds of objects and through Montessori material.
- Revision of Missing numerals, Greater than and Smaller than of two numbers.

Theme for the month **Heavenly bodies**

Children enjoyed learning about heavenly bodies (sun, moon, stars, and planets). They were made aware of how Earth experiences day and night. They were introduced to words such as rotation with the model of the Earth. Children thoroughly enjoyed activities pertaining to the day and night, and they were able to name the eight planets in our Solar system.

Activities

- Children cut out a circle and drew pictures depicting day and night.
- While learning about planets children used handmade chart and crepe paper and made a 2D model of the Earth seen from space.
